

## Terms and Conditions for Institutional Use of ACM Digital Library

1. Authorized Users. The following categories of users of the ACM Digital Library (DL) are recognized as Authorized Users: faculty members (including temporary or exchange faculty); graduate and undergraduate students; staff members of the Institutions listed; registered patrons of public libraries ; and walk-ins.
2. Basic License. ACM grants to the authorized users of the participating institutions of \_\_\_\_\_ consortium (Subscriber) the rights to search, browse, view, and download the content in the DL. All downloading and printing by Authorized Users will be for research and scholarly purposes only, unless approved by ACM in writing. Remote access to the DL by members of the public is not permitted. Authorized Users may include items from the DL for their use in connection with classroom instruction. Authorization is by IP address ranges. Faculty members are allowed to reuse all ACM copyrighted material in the DL for classroom/educational use.
3. Alterations. Neither the Subscriber nor Authorized Users may modify, adapt, transform, translate, or create any derivative work based on any of the materials in the DL. Any copyright notices, or other notices appearing in the DL may not be removed, obscured, or modified in any way.
4. Interlibrary loan of DL material or use of DL material for pedagogical purposes such as coursepacks or electronic reserves is allowed.
5. Term and Termination. The term of this agreement shall begin on the Commencement Date of **July 1st, 2001** and continue for an initial period of one year ("the Term"). The Term may by mutual consent be renewed for additional one year periods, subject to payment of appropriate fees and acceptance thereof by the Licensee. Either party may terminate by providing the other party with 90 days notice of intent to terminate, in writing. In the event of termination or expiration, the institutions that have subscribed for less than 3 consecutive years may not retain any portion of the DL. Institutions who have subscribed for 3 consecutive years or more will have archival access rights through the date of subscription termination, without being tied to the maintenance of a current subscription. Access to such rights will be made available at a fair and reasonable price, to be determined by ACM at that time.
6. Warranties. ACM warrants that it has copyright ownership and/or permission to use all of the materials in the DL. Subscriber warrants that it will use all reasonable efforts to insure the integrity of the DL and the security of the network providing access to Authorized Users.
7. Agent is Authorized Agent of Consortium Members: Agent represents and warrants that it is the authorized agent of each of the Consortium Members and has the right to sign this Agreement, for and on behalf of the Consortium Members, and to bind each of them to this Agreement.
