2023 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The WriteAway community celebrated WriteAway’s ten-year anniversary. WriteAway participating institutions marked the occasion with party packs distributed by the Administrative Centre. The packs, which included treats and promotional materials, were designed to allow each institution to commemorate the occasion alongside tutors and students.

The service used Year-2 Ministry of Post-Secondary Education and Future Skills (PSFS) bridge funding to effectively reduce pressure on participating institutions as staffing meets the “new normal” of increased usage. Strategic application of funding focused on bringing on new participating institutions, and hiring staff - including an Asynchronous Writing Tutor - to staff the service on evenings/weekends and at peak times, as well as to provide Admin Centre support.

WriteAway welcomed new participating institution Coquitlam College. Coquitlam College offers a 2-year Associate of Arts Degree program, an English Certificate program, and a High School program.

Looking ahead to 2024...



On the radar for 2024:

Welcoming new WriteAway Coordinator Kyle Beres who will play an important role in the advancement, coordination, and assessment of WriteAway.

Planning for the effective use of one-time ‘barrier removal’ funding from PSFS. Funding will be used over 2 years to explore removing barriers to participation for BC ELN partner libraries and First Nations-mandated institutions.

Continuing to implement service and training improvements to ensure WriteAway meets participating institution needs.
